Explanation of Application Process

After Application is received, the board members of The Music Factor will review the application and make a decision within five days. Please note that only one board member will review tax-returns and all records will be confidentially filed until they are returned. The Music Factor will not keep records of tax-returns. Instead, The Music Factor will promptly return these records to the family once they are reviewed.

If applicant is given a scholarship an assignment will be given to them within two to three weeks in order for applicant to fulfill his/her 6 hours of volunteer time for The Music Factor. Volunteer time may include, cleaning and straightening up rooms after classes are over, helping set up or take down equipment, helping fold and put together mailers, helping sell snacks, and other volunteer activities.

The Music Factor reserves the right to revoke any scholarship given by The Music Factor due to a student's excessive tardies, poor attendance, consistent discipline problems, or one specific incident.

The Music Factor reserves the right to deny any scholarship request based on any student's past participation problems, an incomplete or late application, a tax-return that does not fulfill the requirements for a scholarship, or The Music Factor's own lack of funds to fill the scholarship request.
